Brief description	Support the Project Staff in the overall organization and management of the activities related to the farming sector and specifically to irrigation systems in the Red Sea State

1. ROLE and RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist and facilitate technical, logistics and operational coordination of personnel employed in the water sector (technicians and executive personnel) in line with the department objectives.
- Assist Head of water sector in conducting a detailed analysis of constraints affecting water use in its different components looking at context-base and ad-hoc solutions.
- Support executive design and supervision of activities related directly or indirectly to water infrastructures in accordance with Head of the water sector and Programme Coordinator.
- Contribute to providing capacity building and technical and managerial support to local technicians working at Government level as well as of local personnel with the aim to improve their technical skills and management of sectoral policies.
- Seek the comprehensive support of locals as well as the participation of communities in all activities which will be implemented in villages/communities. To this extent, several meetings should be organized and carried out before implementing the project.
- Visit assisted communities and villages along with Head of the water sector to assess major constraints affecting water supply and environmental health/sanitation.
- Establish water management committees at village level with the aim of guaranteeing the sustainability of the initiative in terms of economic management, running, operation and maintenance of the water plant facilities.

- Facilitate election and subsequent training of personnel (preferably with a technical background) deputed to run and maintain water plants at the community level.
- Follow up on communities (at least during the first year from the completion) and entering in function of the water plants.
- Identify misuse or potential risk of malfunctioning of plants and promptly inform relevant technician/person in charge about that.
- Other activities related to water sector and related subjects as requested by Programme Coordinator or LTU (Local Technical Unit) director.

2. PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Experience in working with water in agriculture projects within a development cooperation context
- Knowledge of general building maintenance including, masonry plumbing, carpentry, mechanical, etc.
- Technical knowledge on setting up an irrigation system
- Experience in dealing with local contractors
- Languages: fluent in English (speaking and writing) and Arabic (speaking and writing).
- Ability to write clear reports
- Education: University degree in Agronomy or equivalent
- At least 2 years experiences in supervising the construction/rehabilitation of irrigation systems

3. PREFERENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Work experience in Red Sea State
- Work experience with AICS or any other development organizations

4. EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

The selection will be conducted by an Evaluation Commission nominated by the Head of Office in Khartoum according to the following criteria: Education, experience, competencies and preferred requirements (Max 70 points)

Verification of the possession of the essential and preferred requirements according to the documentation presented by the candidate, with reference to the academic titles obtained and the professional experience gained.

Interview (Max 30 points)

The interview will be carried out in person at the premises AICS Office in Port Sudan or through audio/video connection (e.g. Skype).

No reimbursement will be granted to those traveling to Port Sudan for the interview.

The applicants must submit a written and signed declaration request to be admitted to the selection procedure. The request must state:
