PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The DICTORNA [AID 11188] project, financed through the bilateral channel, is part of the 2017-2019 programming of AICS Khartoum aiming at the establishment of a family health system in the States of Red Sea, Kassala, and Khartoum. The program strives to ameliorate SDGs no. 3, 4 and 5 encompassing interventions aimed at the improvement of the overall health conditions of the population in the targeted areas by enhancing the capacity of the National Health Service, and by improving the functional and operational skills of the PHC system.

The Project Assistant is responsible for assisting the projects' staff in the overall management of activities, notably the Project Assistant will be directly responsible for:

4. EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

Education, experience, competencies and preferred requirements (Max 70 points)

Following the deadline set for the receipt of applications, the AICS Human Resources department will check the formal admissibility and completeness of the applications received. Subsequently, the applications that have passed the above-mentioned compliance check will be evaluated based on the scoring specified below.

An Evaluation Commission appointed by the Head of Office in Khartoum will carry out the evaluation; a maximum of 70 points will be assigned based on the essential and preferred requirements according to the documentation presented by the candidate, with reference to the academic titles obtained and the professional experience gained.

Candidates scoring at least 50 points will be included in the shortlist and will be invited for an interview.

Interview (Max 30 points)

The interview will be carried out at the premises AICS Office in Khartoum [33rd street, al-Amarat, Khartoum].

No reimbursement will be granted to those travelling to Khartoum for the interview.

Candidates scoring at least 75 points at the end of the process will be included in a final list of suitable candidates valid till the end of the program.

Youngest candidates will be preferred in case of a final equal score. Scoring will be based on the following criteria:

5. HOW TO APPLY

The submission of the application duly signed should indicate the number of the vacancy announcement. The application shall be written in English and include the Legally Binding Self-declaration (ANNEX I), indicating:

- d) Absence of conviction for any criminal offence or of any criminal process pending.
- e) No involvement in current legal or penal action for crimes against Public Administration.
- f) Studies certificates indicating the dates of issue and the names of Academic Institutions.
- g) Fully possession of political and civil rights.
- h) Not having been dismissed for fault from employment by a Public Administration office.

Any false declaration will imply the rejection of the application.

The application shall also include:

- 1. Motivation letter in English;
- 2. Copy of valid Passport/ID card;
- 3. Curriculum vitae in English;
- 4. Certificates attesting degrees possessed.

The applicant should also provide a telephone number and an email address for communications. The applicant must communicate any changes occurring after the submission of the application for this vacancy.
