

OUR GOALS



End poverty in all its forms everywhere

- Fostering rural-based crop diversification for 1,000 farmers in Red Sea and Kassala
- Providing agricultural tools and inputs for 5,000 smallholder farmers in Red Sea and Kassala
- Provision of livestock (goats) to produce milk for feeding children
- Provision of facilities to combat drought



End hunger, achieve food security, improved nutrition, and promote sustainable agriculture

- Trainings in food education, growth monitoring - weight (GM) and MM
- Rehabilitation of nutrition units at hospital level for host and migrant communities
- Extension and education systems for the production of vegetables & fruits in Gizeh locality
- Timber and pastures for livestock in Gizeh and Haya locality



Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

- 2,000 health screenings for South Sudanese refugees in White Nile State
- Construction and rehabilitation of health facilities, maternity and paediatric wards in Gizeh Locality
- Distribution of drugs and PNC services
- Early detection of pregnancy at risk by strengthening the referral system from rural areas to urban areas



Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all

- Abandoned children in Dar Al-Ansariyah orphanage trained in art, music and cooking
- Development of the Inclusive Education Action Plan 2019-2021
- Supporting formal and informal education for street children



Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls

- Promotion of women health (hygiene, vaccination, nutrition in pregnancy, antenatal care and safe delivery)
- Community awareness on Female Genital Mutilation (FGM)
- Psychological support and legal advice to 100 women imprisoned in Port Sudan Penitentiary



Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all

- Construction and re-connection of water systems for civil and agricultural in Haya, Gizeh, Tobeh, Lashoot, and Kiroda and Gizeh localities
- Environmental campaigns at community level, waste management and water of sanitation
- WASH and hygiene facilities for migrants and host communities in White Nile, Gedaref and Kassala States



Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all

- Installation of solar pumps for drinking water in Gizeh and Tobeh localities
- Installation of solar stoves for the distribution of vegetables used by women in order to increase storage capacity in Port Sudan, Kassala and Tobeh localities



Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all

- Establishment of Cooperatives to develop revolving funds in rural Kassala, Gizeh, Port Sudan and Tobeh localities
- Technical trainings to improve cropping techniques



Reduce inequality within and among countries

- Distribution of National Health Insurance cards to women headed families, orphans and PwDs
- Development of inclusion centres (points, food-cooking classes) for PwDs, other vulnerable groups within migrant and hosting communities
- Improvement of the Federal Welfare System for child protection
- Trainings on combating transnational organized crime including smuggling of migrants and human trafficking



Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable

- Development of inclusive public structures and increase of public service accessibility
- Trainings in physical usage and methods of SHU coexistence in Hadera and Dar Ansa and Dar Ansa villages



Strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development

- Data collection and analysis on abandoned children with disabilities housed in Khartoum orphanages
- Establishment of data collection units in the 18 States of Sudan within the Councils for PwDs
