The Italian Agency for Development and Cooperation (AICS) in Sudan, in the framework of the program “Support Migrants and Host Communities in Improving access to Safe Water and Sanitation”, financed by the European Union, promotes a selection for the above-mentioned position.

<i>Brief description</i>	The WASH Field Engineer supports and assists the Program Technical Coordinator in both the the design and supervision related to the program.
<i>Duty station</i>	Gedaref and areas of intervention (Kassala)
<i>Contract duration</i>	5 months with 3 months’ probation and possible 6 months extension
<i>Salary</i>	870 monthly/gross
<i>Contract start</i>	1 st of February 2020
<i>Deadline for application</i>	12:00 (GMT +2) on the 20th of January 2020

1. MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSABILITIES

- Assist the Program Technical Coordinator in the design of new interventions according to standard models developed by AICS and in agreement with the relevant Line Ministries
- Direction and supervision of SDN11 civil works contracts;
 - Rehabilitation of hafirs in the target areas of the program;
 - Execution and supervision of water supply and sanitation systems;
- Technical assistance to Beneficiaries after hand over of Water supply and sanitation systems and other newly erected or rehabilitated buildings in Kassala and Gedaref State
- Any other civil works identified and executed by the AICS

The employee during his/her employment agreement shall perform the following services:

- Preliminary Surveys
- Project design Arch./Structural/Electrical/Plumbing
- BOQs Architectural/Structural/Electrical/Plumbing
- Preparation of Tenders and/or Requests for Offers (including technical and procedural support to bidders)
- Periodical Site Supervision and Work Direction
- Issue of Preliminary as well as Final Acceptance Certificates upon Preliminary and Final Acceptance Test (hand over procedures)
- Coordination with Line Ministries Technical Referents for approval on design

With reference to the above-mentioned tasks, the employee is requested to work under the supervision of the Program Technical Coordinator, and to prepare and submit a detailed report including photos about the site surveys and inspections in English.

All technical drawings and documents (BOQ's, calculations, etc.) shall be submitted upon request in a timely manner, according to the specific indications.

2 TECHNICAL/ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- Degree in Civil Engineering, Architecture or related studies
- Excellent Arabic (written and spoken)
- Fluent in English, both spoken and written
- Proficient in using computers including AutoCAD/ArchiCAD, Microsoft programs (excel, word), outlook and internet
- Excellent communications skills
- Punctuality and total reliability

3 PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Essential requirements

- At least three (3) years of relevant and provable experience as Site Engineer and/or Field Engineer and/or Civil Works Supervisor in in major civil works related to residential and/or commercial and/or service buildings (schools, health centres, etc.)
- At least one (1) year of relevant and provable experience in preparation of Bills of Quantities/QS

Preferential requirements

- Previous experience working in the field of development with INGOs, UN agencies or Cooperation agencies
- Previous experience working in Eastern Sudan
- Previous direct experience in the Civil Works materials' market (procurement and/or sales)
- Knowledge of AICS administrative procedures and PRAG procedure.

4 REPORTING

The appointed person shall prepare the following reports during his/her assignment

- Monthly report of all the activities carried out according to the agreed upon format

The reports shall be in English.

5. EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

The selection will be conducted by an Evaluation Commission nominated by the Head of Office in Khartoum according to the following criteria: Education, experience, competencies and preferred requirements (**Max 70 points**)

Verification of the possession of the essential and preferred requirements according to the documentation presented by the candidate, with reference to the academic titles obtained and the professional experience gained.
