<i>Brief description</i>	The Field Engineer supports and assists the Civil Works Project Officer in both the design and supervision activities related to the program.

<i>Salary</i>	From 800 to 1.000,00 euro month/gross based on the experience of the candidate

1 MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSABILITIES

- Assist the Civil Work Project Officer in the design of new health facilities in the target areas of the program according to standard models developed by the Embassy of Italy in Sudan in agreement with the Federal Ministry of Health
- Rehabilitation of health facilities in the target areas of the program
- Execution of water supply and sanitation systems
- Execution of solar systems for electric power production
- Technical assistance to beneficiaries after hand over of Health Centers and other newly erected or rehabilitated buildings in other Red Sea State and Kassala State localities
- Any other civil works identified and executed by the Italian Cooperation

The employee during his/her employment agreement shall perform the following services:

- Preliminary Surveys
- Project design Arch./Structural/Electrical/Plumbing
- BOQs Architectural/Structural/Electrical/Plumbing
- Preparation of Tenders and/or Requests for Offers (including technical and procedural support to bidders)
- Periodical Site Supervision and Work Direction
- Issue of Preliminary as well as Final Acceptance Certificates upon Preliminary and Final Acceptance Test (hand over procedures)
- Coordination with MoH Technical Referents for approval on design
- Coordination with other SDN13 functions as well as representatives of other Italian Cooperation projects

The employee might occasionally be requested to carry out some of the above listed tasks also as regards to sites and projects located in the States of Kassala and Red Sea, as well as attend meetings in the mentioned States and/or at Khartoum.

With reference to the above-mentioned tasks, the employee is requested to work under the supervision of the Civil Works Project Officer, remaining accountable to the Team Leader, and to prepare and submit a detailed report including photographs about the site surveys and inspections in English within 48 hours, as per the agreed format.

All technical drawings and documents (BOQ's, calculations, etc.) shall be submitted upon request in a timely manner, according to the specific indications.
