Emergency Ngo (implementing)

- Activities started in 2007 providing high standard pediatric and adult cardiac surgery. All the service all free of charge. The Salam Cardiologic Center in Soba is a regional hospital hosting patients from Egypt, Libya, Chad, Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, Uganda, Kenya, Ethiopia and Eritrea

What has been done?

- 8.700 surgical operation
- 74.635 cardiology visits

DICTORNA – Family Medicine



- To improve the health of the population in the four States through the strengthening of the Primary Health Care System (PHC) with a focus on the establishment of Family Medicine and supporting the National Health Insurance system.

What has been done?

- Promotion and integration of the Family Medicine approach in the health system: training of health personnel, strengthening of health systems and increased the access to health services;
- On-going rehabilitation of 7 Health Centers located in the four States to be staffed and equipped as Family Health Centers(FHC). In Khartoum the centers are: **Shambat Center, Alzihour Center, Treat Albija Center, Samir Center; Samir FHC** - will become a model for the inclusion of people with disabilities, to facilitate access to health services, community cohesion and awareness on the issue of disability and its implications in order to promote civil and social progress for an active and participate citizenship;

Humanitarian Aid



- Supporting the most vulnerable communities affected by acute and moderate malnutrition, drinking water issues, disaster and emergency situations

What has been done?

Wash: Purchase of a tank for Yarmouk school in Mayo and supply of cleaning and disinfection actions against communicable diseases (watery diarrhea) during last year sit-in

Health: anaerobic biodigestion system; supply of PPE for the personnel of the FMOH for the Covid-19 emergency; supply of medicines for diseases such as diabetes, blood pressure, asthma; rental of 3 ambulances for Covid 19 patients; supply of plastic tarpaulins and mosquito nets; support to the central laboratory in Khartoum to contribute to the improvement of the diagnosis of Chikungunya and Dengue

Food distribution: Dar Es Salam neighborhood and at isolation center "Ibrahim Shams Camp";

Structural rehabilitation

Capacity building and vocational training: works of ordinary maintenance at Maymouna Bint Elharis school through the local community.

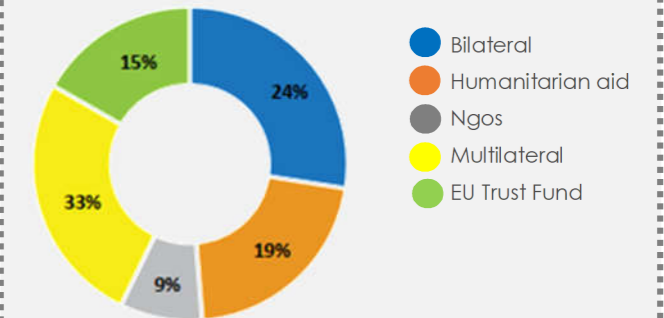
What will be done? Refresh exhibition - cataloguing system - Rehabilitate premises and facilities

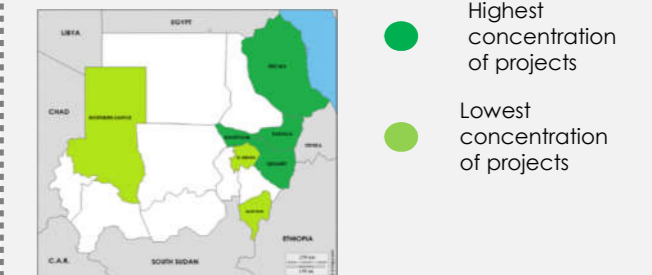
