**Frequently asked questions (FAQ)**

**Question n.1** – Project proposals which only support and target *IDPs* and *migrants* could be eligible for funding under this opportunity?

**Answer n.1:**

No. As clearly defined in the grant guidelines (section 1.2.), the direct beneficiaries of this grant must be:

- Working age people with disabilities<sup>1</sup> (+18 years old). It includes also IDP and migrants (with disabilities).

**Question n.2** – Can national Sudanese NGOs apply for the grant?

**Answer n.2:**

Yes, as long as they meet the requirements listed under the section 2. “Rules for this Call for Proposals” of the guidelines.

**Question n.3** – Disability is a core part and a cross-cutting theme of our protection and empowerment programming. Are we eligible for the grant?

**Answer n.3:**

The eligibility criteria for this grant are listed on section 2.1. of the guidelines document “Eligibility Criteria”. After the deadline, the appointed Evaluation Committee will evaluate each proposal to determine their eligibility.

Please note that the criteria listed in letter e, f, g, of section 2.1.1. apply to programmes implemented worldwide (Sudan included).

<sup>1</sup> According to the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD), “disability is an evolving concept” and person with disabilities are those people who have “long-term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which in interaction with various barriers may hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others”.
