Thank you for participating in the above-mentioned tender procedure. I regret to inform you, however, that your tender was not admissible for the following reason:

based on the <u>Instruction to Tenderers</u> (page 6/9 art. 12.2. Evaluation of financial offers) and the template <u>Evaluation Grid</u>, stating that only tenders with average scores of at least 75 points qualify for the financial evaluation, your tender did not qualify for the financial evaluation since it did not reach a score of 75 points (see table below)

For your information, the evaluation committee recommended that the contract should be awarded to *Avrio Impact*.

Your scores awarded by the evaluators according to the award criteria, as well as those for the selected tender, were as follows:
